this book results from a long term research effort aimed at tackling complex non standard packing issues which arise in space engineering the main research objective is to optimize cargo loading and arrangement in compliance with a set of stringent rules complicated geometrical aspects are also taken into account in addition to balancing conditions based on attitude control specifications chapter 1 introduces the class of non standard packing problems studied chapter 2 gives a detailed explanation of a general model for the orthogonal packing of tetris like items in a convex domain a number of additional conditions are looked at in depth including the prefixed orientation of subsets of items the presence of unusable holes separation planes and structural elements relative distance bounds as well as static and dynamic balancing requirements the relative feasibility sub problem which is a special case that does not have an optimization criterion is discussed in chapter 3 this setting can be exploited by introducing an ad hoc objective function aimed at facilitating the finding of integer feasible solutions the third chapter also discusses the issue of
